FINANCIAL STATEMENTS AND ACTIVITY REPORT 2021

Redeemer International Church Maastricht was founded on the 27th of December 2018, therefore the year of 2021 was our third official financial year. Again a year full of challenges and limitations because of the ongoing covid pandemic.

During the year of 2021, the work of the church was provided for by the grace of God and through the continued support of its members who gave generously their time, energy and financial resources.

Income

The total church giving was at € 119.131,62. This is an increase of about 9% in comparison to 2020. Other giving was at € 4500,- . We received a grant from New Ground of € 64.934,38 to employ Henk Kersten. This brings the total 2021 revenues to € 184.066,-

Expenses

The total church expenses were € 114.746,40. This is about 10% less than our set budget of € 125.000,-.

Net result

The net positive result for the 2021 year was € 3.112,05

Financial position

As of end 2021 the church's financial assets were about € 31.500,- most of which were reservations & reserves.

By the grace of God, Redeemer International Church Maastricht remains in a good financial position to be able to continue its mission of spreading the gospel of Jesus Christ, to account for potentially unexpected expenses, and to respond in giving to the purposes which God might call us to.
