## FINANCIAL STATEMENTS AND ACTIVITY REPORT 2022

Redeemer International Church Maastricht was founded on the 27th of December 2018, therefore the year of 2022 was our fourth official financial year. A year of coming out of the Covid pandemic and being able to have regular and full in-person meetings again.

Again, God has done an amazing work in our midst and to Him belongs all the glory! God enabled us to do many things according to our mission & vision and what we feel He is calling us to as described below:
